Materials placed in the bins are densified into ingots, which can be manufactured into a variety of materials. The Tiny House Community has the machinery for this process! Foam must be clean, dry, and free of tape and labels for recycling. Items accepted: Foam packaging from appliances, furniture, coolers, etc. Food service foam like egg cartons, trays, takeout clamshells, cups, and plates.
